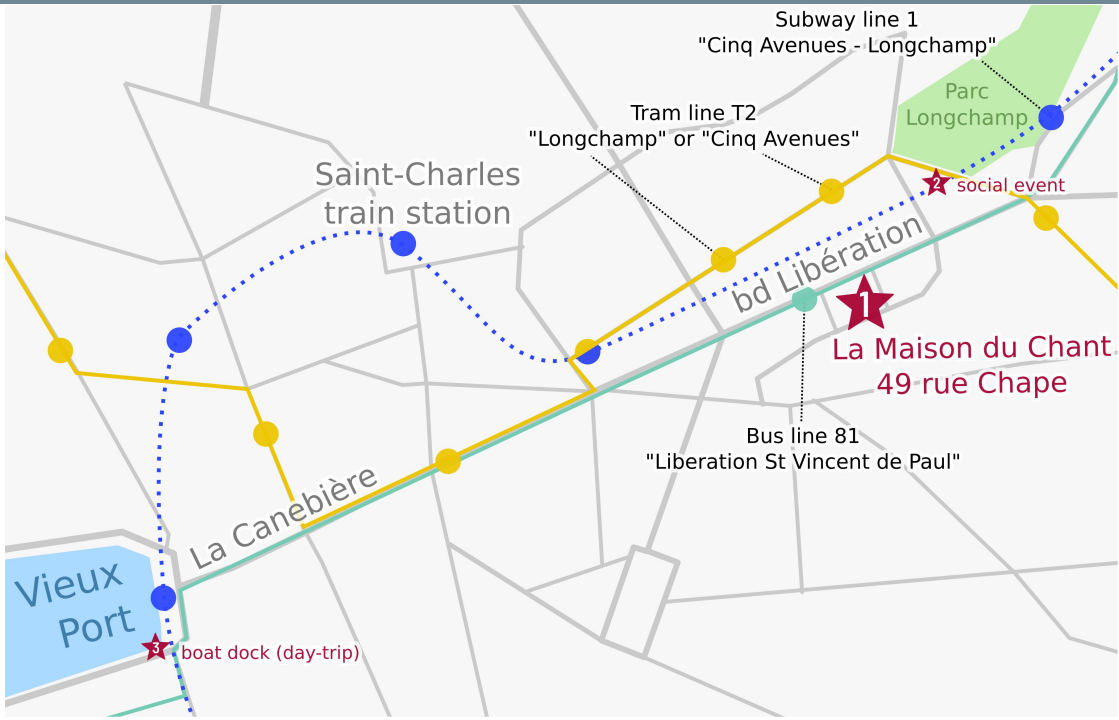

# GETTING AROUND

## Best places to visit

- Take a break at the **Parc Longchamp** near the DebConf venue
- Walking on the **Vieux Port** (with the fish market early in the morning), inside **Le Fort Saint-Jean**, on **MuCEM** roof top and the **Cathedral La Major**
- Hiking and swimming in **Les Calanques** (les Goudes, Callongue, Sormiou, Sugiton, En Vau, Port Pin, Port Miou etc.)
- Admire the view in **Notre Dame De La Garde** (day or night)
- Walking in the neighbourhood around **Le Panier**
