- The Video was registered with the U.S. Copyright Office and was given 15. Copyright Registration Number PA 2-211-871.
 - B. **Defendants' Infringing Activities**
- Defendants ran the Video on the Website. See: 16. https://www.instagram.com/p/B2VU5TVj7HC/. Screenshots of the Video on the Website are attached hereto as Exhibit A.
 - 17. The Video garnered over 13 million views.
- 18. Defendants did not license the Video from Plaintiff for the Website or any other use.
- 19. Defendants did not have Plaintiff's permission or consent to publish the Video on the Website.

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FIRST CLAIM FOR RELIEF	
(COPYRIGHT INFRINGEMENT	[]

(17 U.S.C. §§ 106, 501)

- 20. Plaintiff incorporates by reference each and every allegation contained in Paragraphs 1-19 above.
- Defendants infringed Plaintiff's copyright in the Video by reproducing 21. and publicly displaying the Video on the Website. Defendants were not, and have never been, licensed or otherwise authorized to reproduce, publicly display, distribute and/or use the Video.
- 22. The acts of Defendants complained of herein constitute infringement of Plaintiff's copyright and exclusive rights under copyright in violation of Sections 106 and 501 of the Copyright Act, 17 U.S.C. §§ 106 and 501.
- 23. Upon information and belief, the foregoing acts of infringement by Defendants were willful, intentional, and purposeful, in disregard of and indifference to Plaintiff's rights.
- 24. As a direct and proximate cause of the infringement by the Defendants of Plaintiff's copyright and exclusive rights under copyright, Plaintiff is entitled to damages and Defendants' profits pursuant to 17 U.S.C. § 504(b) for the infringement.

That Plaintiff be awarded either: (a) Plaintiff's actual damages and Defendants' profits, gains or advantages of any kind attributable to Defendants' infringement of Plaintiff's Video; or (b) alternatively, statutory damages of up to \$150,000 per copyrighted work infringed pursuant to 17 U.S.C. § 504;
- That Defendants be required to account for all profits, income, receipts, 4. or other benefits derived by Defendants as a result of their infringement;
- 5. That Plaintiff be awarded her costs, expenses and attorneys' fees pursuant to 17 U.S.C. § 505;
- That Plaintiff be awarded pre-judgment interest; and 6.
- 7. Such other and further relief as the Court may deem just and proper.
